Re: OSHA’s COVID-19 Vaccination and Testing ETS

Dear Governor Whitmer:

As Michigan employers grapple with the Occupational Safety and Health Administration’s (OSHA) emergency temporary standard (ETS) requiring employers with 100 or more employees to ensure each of their workers is fully vaccinated or tests for COVID-19 on at least a weekly basis, we write to ask for your Administration’s support.

Many employers are pursuing the testing option for their workforce and are concerned about testing costs and availability to cover a potentially significant portion of their workforce.

We formally request the Administration’s support in procuring and paying for these tests for the duration of the six-month ETS with Federal dollars that that have already been appropriated by the State Legislature for testing and vaccination. Whether through a grant program or other method, any support will help employers and their employees shoulder the incredible burden of complying with this ETS.

While the ETS was stayed by the U.S. Court of Appeals for the 5th Circuit, that is only applicable to the 5th Circuit. We are encouraging employers to move forward with crafting policies and implementation strategies to comply with the mandate should it go forward, and the issue of testing supplies are a major concern.

We hope to speak with you or a member of your Administration about this issue soon. Thank you for your consideration and we look forward to your support.
